
10. Quiz Competition Teaching and Learning

2024-2025

As part of the teacher education curriculum, the Compulsory Teaching Practice for the academic year 2024-2025 commenced on 9th September 2024 and extended over a period of 16 weeks. This intensive school internship program served as a crucial phase in the professional development of our student-teachers, providing them with hands-on teaching experience in real classroom settings. 

- Strengthening teamwork and academic excellence.


